Etymology. Battle is a loanword from the Old French bataille, first attested in 1297, from Late Latin battalia, meaning "exercise of soldiers and gladiators in fighting and fencing", from Late Latin (taken from Germanic) battuere "beat", from which the English word battery is also derived via Middle English batri.
